Dear Parent and Caregivers

Further to our letter sent yesterday, the Project Managers have advised us of a change to the original time frame for the demolition work. Can you please therefore disregard the information given in our previous letter and note the new time frame mentioned below.

Demolition and construction work at the senior campus will commence from 7 February 2019. The buildings have been fenced off to keep the construction area separate from the general public.

Prior to demolition of the buildings, due to the age of the school, a full asbestos assessment report and management plan has been completed by the Ministry of Education. The report and plan have identified that any asbestos containing materials are low risk and will be fully removed following all government health and safety guidelines.

This work will take place over a five-week period and you may notice workmen in the area, some with protective clothing, during this time. Demolition work is due to be completed by the middle of March, but is weather dependent.

During the construction phase of the new school, hours of work are expected to be mainly weekdays, with a minimum of weekends, starting no earlier than 7:00am and generally finishing by 5:30pm.

The exact length of the construction of the new buildings will be dictated by weather and other conditions outside of our control, but we are expecting it to be completed by the end of May 2020.
