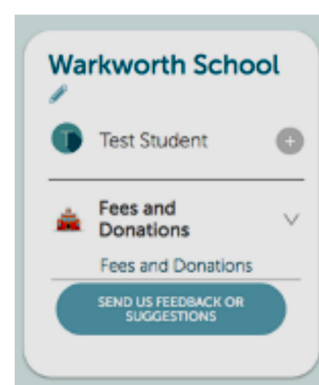
Senior Swimming Sports
