We would like to give you prior notice that the 2023 Community 5 Camp will be held at Marsden Point Christian Camp, 89 One Tree Point, Ruakaka (www.marsdenbay.co.nz) from Wednesday 29 March to Friday 31 March 2023. This is two nights and three days.

The cost will be \$170.00 per child which includes accommodation, transport and a trip to the Adventure Forest. You are welcome to pay this in instalments beforehand, either through the school office or via internet banking. Whichever form of payment you choose, we do ask that payment in full is made prior to the camp.

Further information and camp notices, including the permission slip, health profile, student contract and extra parent help forms will be sent home early in the new school year.

Please be prepared for the fact that you may not be selected as a helper.

If your offer is accepted, please make the necessary arrangements to take leave from your usual work and/or home commitments for the period 29-31 March 2023

It is important to note, we do look to cover particular skills when selecting our parent/caregiver helpers, so please let us know *all* of your skills and attributes, e.g. what experience do you have with managing groups of children, involvement with other school camps, sports groups, Girl Guides, etc, or specific knowledge or skills of bushcraft, camp cooking, first-aid, playing the guitar, yoga, etc?
