LEARNING FOCUSES

TOPIC

We are joining in with our whole school as we investigate the concept of Tūragawaewae (Our Place to Stand). We will be learning about ourselves and who and what we connect to. Learners will explore their place in the school and how as a school community we embody the school values and display the school dispositions.

LITERACY

Literacy is a time for us to explore the world around us. This term we are focusing on the development of our sound knowledge which students will use in both their reading and writing. Students will also be engaging with quality texts that will support their vocabulary.

NUMERACY

We are furthering our knowledge of numbers and how we can use them. This involves forwards and backwards counting sequences, knowledge of before and after number sequence, digit formation and place value knowledge.
