Kia ora Parents and Caregivers

We have had a very settled term to date with our learners being focused and enthusiastic about their learning. Learning this term has been detailed in the newsletter from the teachers in your child's Community. You can also see them on the school website from this <u>link</u>.

School Cross Country

This will be held next Tuesday, 8 August, assuming the weather is sufficiently fine. Please continue encouraging your child to develop their stamina to run or walk the required distance for their year-level.

Year 0 & 1 – 600m, approx. 1 lap of the field

Year 2 – 850m, approx. 1.5 laps of the field

Year 3 & 4, 1200m, approx. 2 laps of the field

Year 5 & 6, 1500m, approx. 1 lap of the field, up to and along Kasper Street, back into the school and complete a second lap of the field.

This is part of the physical education and wellbeing programme and we anticipate all children being able to participate at a level that suits them, whether that is running the distance or walking it.

We look forward to seeing you there to encourage and support your child on the day.
