Dear Parents and Caregivers

We are off on an exciting adventure as part of our inquiry this term which is *How to be Kaitiaki (guardians) of the Forest and our Ecosystem*.

We will be going to Kowhai Park on Tuesday 14 May at 9:30am to explore our local ecosystem and identify the native trees, animals and insects. We will be returning to school around 11:30am at the latest.

We will require at least 6 parents for the trip, to walk with the Community down from school, assist in crossing Hill Street, help guide the students through Kowhai Park and assist with the return walk back to school.

Students will need to bring:

- Morning tea and lunch (including a water bottle)
- Enclosed shoes (no crocs or slide on shoes)
- Raincoat (just in case)

There are risks associated with involvement in any school EOTC events and these risks cannot be completely eliminated. However, the school has identified any foreseeable risks or hazards and implemented correct management procedures to eliminate or minimise those hazards. The children will be strictly supervised and will have a good understanding of boundaries and rules before we leave school.

We are looking forward to a wonderful day enjoying the experience of walking through our local park and to sharing our learning with you.
