We would like to give you prior notice that the 2023 Community 6 Camp will be held at Chosen Valley Christian Camp, 53 Turner Rd, Ararimu (<https://chosenvalley.org>) from **Tuesday 7 May to Friday 10 May 2024**. This is three nights and four days.

The cost will be \$255 per child which includes accommodation, transport and a trip to the Vector Wero Whitewater Park. You are welcome to pay this in instalments beforehand, either through the school office or via internet banking. Whichever form of payment you choose, we do ask that payment in full is made prior to the camp.
